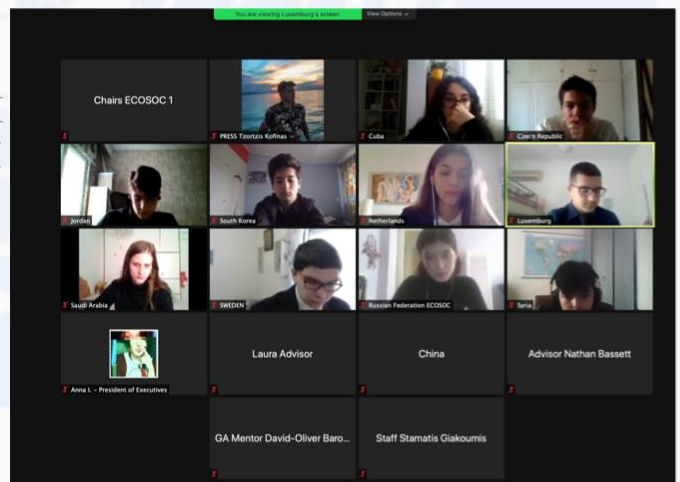
NOW IT'S TIME FOR SOME COMMENTS FROM OUR GOSSIP BOX!!

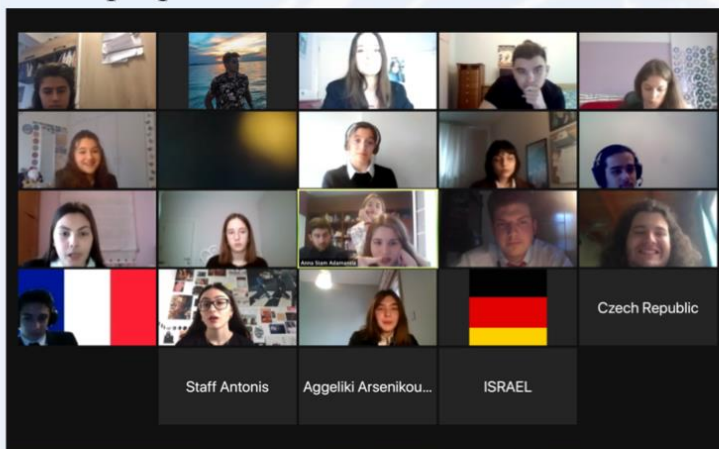

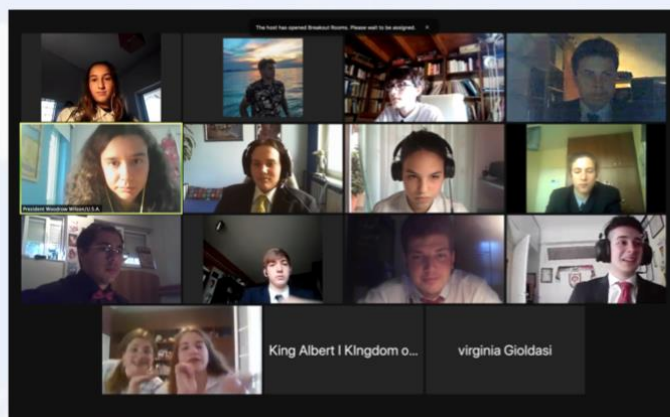

From one person, to a country, to a continent, to the entire globe the disease has affected millions of people, forcing governments to shut their borders and people to shut their doors towards the virus and to each other. Between the countries xenophobia has been developed, whilst cases of depression, rates of suicide, domestic violence and drug abuse have reached a higher step on the staircase.
